ST FRANCIS UPDATE

It is a huge disappointment that work on the church roof has been so slow and consistently delayed. Thankfully, we will have the church for Holy Week, but two more sides of the windows have yet to be done. When will it be finished? Completion date was to be February 14th !!! The plan is that the workers will return on Easter Tuesday and complete the job in two weeks. That timescale will only involve one weekend on which we will have to use the hall once more. The total work will cost in the region of £115,000, plus we have to pay for an asbestos inspection and look at a new sound system. This leaves the parish with a considerable amount of money to pay back, as we are paying via loans. We will really have to watch our pennies for the foreseeable future.
