# NEW TRANSLATION OF THE LECTIONARY

The New Translation of the Lectionary has been produced and will come into use in England and Wales on the first Sunday in Advent (1st December) this year. We will notice immediately that this not a new collection or revised readings but a new publication of the Lectionary using a different scripture translation — the content remains the same. So, the reading given for each Sunday and weekday will be the same as we currently have but they will look and sound different from that which we are used to. It will mean, of course, for those of us who like to use a Weekday or Sunday missal, either to prepare the readings or to reflect on them, or even to follow the Word of God as it's proclaimed in the liturgy, we may wish to get a new missal. #### **UNIVERSALIS APP**

The Universalis app is available to download to your phone/I pad. This app will give you all the prayers and readings for Mass for every day as well as the whole of the divine office. There is even a special filter for Clifton diocese. The payment is a one off and there are no further subscriptions. It is much cheaper than a missal and far more comprehensive.

#### **ROOF UPDATE - ST FRANCIS**

At that stage we will have to change some Mass times to fit in with the use of the hall. We will also have a consultation about weekend Masses.

# BLESSING OF BAMBINELLI - 15th DEC

This is a beautiful Advent Tradition - Bambinelli Sunday, Blessing the Christ Child - which has been celebrated in Rome for over thirty years and helps children and young people to prepare for Jesus. Each family brings the Christ Child from their own crib or nativity scene and the Pope blesses it during the noon Angelus that day. It is a wonderful way to bring family and parish together. Following that tradition, I encourage families to bring the baby Jesus from your own cribs to church on the Third Sunday of Advent and, at the end of Mass, I will bless the Bambinelli which have been brought to church. Everyone is welcome to take part – young and old alike.

#### CONFIRMATION

Our joint parish Confirmation programme will begin with an information evening in January. The programme is made up of a number of sessions including a retreat away day. This is for anyone in school Y9 or above. Dates to be confirmed. The Confirmation Mass will be celebrated by Bishop Bosco at St Francis Church, on Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> June at 7.00pm.
